## Day 1: Building on the Rock

### Devotional:

When building a house, the foundation is crucial. No matter how beautiful the structure above, without a solid foundation, the house cannot stand. The same principle applies to our spiritual lives. We need a foundation that's unshakeable, unmovable, and eternally reliable. That foundation is God Himself. ### Bible Verse:

### Reflection Question:

What areas of your life need to be more firmly grounded in God as your foundation?

### Quote:

### Prayer:

Heavenly Father, help me build my life on You, the solid rock. Show me where I've tried to build on shifting sand, and give me the wisdom and courage to establish everything in my life upon Your unchanging truth. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Day 2: Personal Relationship, Not Just Recognition

### Devotional:

There's a vast difference between knowing about someone and knowing them personally. Many people know facts about God, but fewer experience the intimacy of a personal relationship with Him. ### Bible Verse:

### Quote:

### Prayer:

## Day 3: Finding Strength in Weakness

### Devotional:

### Prayer:

Dear God, thank You that Your strength is made perfect in my weakness. Help me to rely on Your power rather than my own abilities. Show me how to rest in Your strength today. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Day 4: Protected in the Battle

### Devotional:

## Day 5: Standing Above Life's Storms

### Devotional:

### Bible Verse:

### Reflection Question

### Quote:

A high tower gives you a vantage point above everything else. Above everything else. You can see the enemy come, you can see and look over your life.

### Prayer:

Lord, lift me above my circumstances to see things from Your perspective. Help me trust Your view over my limited understanding. Thank You for being my strong tower. In Jesus' name, Amen.
